The The SL-1200/Mk.II remains the industry standard turntable for DJ applications. Its popularity stems from a combination of great design, durability, and the essential features required for turntablism i.e. responsive speed control, good tracking and a hi-torque direct drive motor. The built in Quartz Synthesizer circuitry locks the platter speed, as dictated by the pitch control, to ensure accurate playback under the most demanding conditions. In addition, the whole turntable is housed in a precision molded, aluminum die-cast cabinet with heavy rubber base to prevent feedback. Since its introduction on to the market, many competitors have tried to duplicate and improve the design, yet none so far have surpassed the build quality and service life of this classic turntable.
